The Chair may call speakers to order for failure to comply with these requirements, and may, at their discretion, impose time limits on individual speakers or questioners to ensure an orderly and efficient meeting. The Board may permit remote testimony via telephone or video conferencing. If remote testimony is allowed for a specific subject, this information will be included in the official meeting notice so that individuals who wish to testify remotely may request to do so. Requests to testify remotely must be submitted to the Chair prior to the scheduled meeting. The Chair will approve a remote testimony schedule, which will specify time limits, allocation among proponents, opponents, and informational witnesses. Only individuals who receive approval and submit a completed, signed witness form will be permitted to testify remotely. Written testimony may be submitted electronically to the Board's administrative office prior to the meeting for inclusion in the official record.
